Schedule of Fees and Charges

EFFECTIVE DATE: August 1, 2025

The Federal Grain Inspection Service (FGIS) must approve all fees for official services and Official Agencies will assess only those fees appearing on their current approved fee schedule.

REGULAR HOURS: 7:00 AM to 3:00 PM Monday through Friday except holidays.

REGULAR HOURLY RATE: \$35.10 per hour per person.

Rates are assessed in quarter hour increments. SCI reserves the right to determine the number of personnel to properly provide the service requested.

OVERTIME HOURS: One and one-half the regular rate for work performed on Saturday and other than regular hours.

SUNDAY and HOLIDAY HOURS: Two times the regular rate. Holidays are: New Year's Day, Presidents Day, Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, and after 11:00 AM on Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve. Holidays which fall on Saturday will be celebrated on the preceding Friday, those which fall on Sunday will be celebrated on the following Monday.

STANDBY RATES: Will be charged at the applicable hourly rate for delays not caused by the agency. A minimum call out charge of four (4) hours will be assessed at the applicable hourly rate for service outside of regular hours.

MILEAGE RATE: The IRS standard mileage rate will be assessed per vehicle for all services performed basis service point's city limits. Any change to the mileage rate is effective when the IRS changes its standard rate. Mileage may be prorated when more than one point is provided service per trip.

OFFICIAL INSPECTION SERVICES: Mileage and delivery charges are in addition to unit fees listed below. Standby and travel hours will be assessed at applicable hourly rates. Overnight lodging costs and per diem will be charged when incurred.

ONSITE LAB STAFFING: Applicable hourly rate for inspector(s) and or technician(s) plus travel time, mileage and unit fees.

EXTENDED LOAD TIME FEE: On-Site minimum of seven (7) railcars per hour average for the train. Amounts less than seven (7) railcars per hour will be billed at the current rail-car rate. Maximum charge \$740.00 per train.

LATE PAYMENT FEE: 1.5% per month may be assessed on all past due balances with a minimum charge of \$10.00.

PERSONNEL SAFETY: It is the customer's responsibility to make the grain or stowage area accessible. On barges and railcars SCI employees do not open or close doors or lids. On top of railcars there must be a minimum of two people present at all times. This can be two SCI employees or one SCI employee and



one customer employee. This is to “render aid if needed” which could be to call for assistance.

FGIS SUPERVISION FEES: In addition to all other applicable fees, FGIS supervision fees for domestic U.S. grain shipments inspected and/or weighed, including land carrier shipments to Canada and Mexico, will be assessed at the current per metric ton rate identified in FGIS Directive 9180.74 Service Fees and Billing Codes, Attachment 2. Invoices will identify assessed supervision fees as separate line items per applicable carrier/unit type.

FGIS ADMINISTRATIVE TONNAGE FEES: In addition to all other applicable fees, FGIS administrative tonnage fees for export grain shipments inspected and/or weighed, excluding land carrier shipments to Canada and Mexico, will be assessed at the current per metric ton rate identified in FGIS Directive 9180.74 Service Fees and Billing Codes, Attachment 1. Invoices will identify assessed administrative tonnage fees as separate line items per applicable carrier/unit type.
