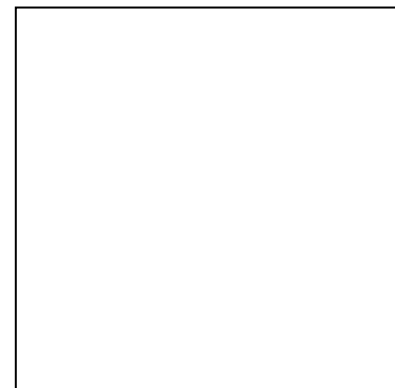
The Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS), Veterinary Services (VS) certifies that:

1. Highly pathogenic avian influenza (HPAI) is a notifiable disease in the United States.
2. The United States has been free from HPAI for the past 28 days following a stamping out policy in accordance with Article 10.4.6 of the World Organization for Animal Health (WOAH) Terrestrial Animal Health Code (2021).
AND/OR
The eggs were not derived from poultry originating from areas within the 10km radius restricted zone(s) established around a premises affected with HPAI in poultry as defined by the WOAH.
3. The eggs covered by this certificate were produced by birds originating from breeding flocks classified as Salmonella enteritidis (SE) Clean, which have not been identified within 90 days before shipment by the U.S. Department of Agriculture, Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service, as being infected with SE, including SE phage type 4.
4. No cases of velogenic Newcastle disease (VND) have been reported in commercial laying chicken flocks in the 10km radius zone(s) from which the eggs originated for at least 90 days prior to export.
5. The eggs are unfertilized and originate from farms participating in the National Poultry Improvement Plan.
6. The eggs have a fully developed shell, were washed and sanitized and packed in new and clean packaging, in accordance with USDA-approved methods.
