The U.S. Department of Agriculture, Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service, Veterinary Services certifies that:

No cases of high pathogenicity avian influenza (HPAI), as defined by the World Organization for Animal Health (WOAH), have been confirmed in commercial laying chicken flocks in the County from where the eggs originated for 28 days prior to lay.

No cases of velogenic Newcastle disease (VND), as defined by the WOAH, have been reported in commercial laying chicken flocks in the county(ies) from where the eggs originated for 28 days prior to lay.

The eggs were produced and packed in an establishment in a county where no diseases notifiable to the World Organization for Animal Health (WOAH) for which poultry is susceptible have been detected.

The birds from which the eggs come are from farms that participate in the National Poultry Improvement Plan (NPIP). The shell eggs covered by this certificate were produced by commercial birds originating from Salmonella enteritidis (SE)-certified breeding flocks which have not been identified within 30 days before shipment by the U.S. Department of Agriculture, Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service, as being infected with SE.

The egg's surfaces were cleaned and sanitized immediately after collection to remove fecal contamination prior to packing, using an approved sanitizing agent, in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
