Invitation No. 34 - Peanuts

The Warehouse and Commodity Management Division (WCMD), under authority of the United States Warehouse Act (USWA) invites offers to purchase peanuts in-store for unrestricted use in accordance with the terms and conditions of Invitation No. 34 - Peanuts.

The peanuts will be sold **AS-IS** and released in-store at location listed above. USDA will not pay the loadout charges. Prior to submitting a bid, interested parties are advised to check with the storing warehouse operator regarding scheduling, quality and any applicable charges including fumigation and grading/inspection fees. The transferee (buyer) will be responsible for any of these applicable charges. Any differences must be settled between the buyer and the warehouse operator.

Potential buyers will be required to enter a per-ton bid (no more than two decimal places). Each bid will be analyzed independently, and no offer can be contingent upon the acceptance of other offers. WCMD reserves the right to reject any or all offers. Proposals from vendors with a history of unsatisfactory performance or limited relevant experience may be considered non-responsive or may receive a lower evaluation rating.

The transferee (buyer) is responsible for paying loadout charges in accordance with the warehouse operator's public tariff, not to exceed \$20 per ton, plus storage charges incurred from the day after the date of contract. The date of the contract is the date the buyer is notified by WCMD that its bid is successful.

Buyers of peanuts must remit to WCMD payment equal to 80% of contract value within five business days after the date of contract with final settlement due after final load out. If payment is not received within five business days of contract date, interest will accrue for the account of the buyer from the first calendar day after the date of the contract through the date payment is received by WCMD. It is not acceptable for a buyer to withhold payment in favor of continuing to pay interest to WCMD.

This is an open-ended solicitation and bids may be submitted at any time. Successful bidders will be notified within 24 hours of bid submission. All bids may be modified or withdrawn within 24 hours of submission. Bids submitted on weekends or federal holidays will be reviewed on the next business day, with notifications issued accordingly
